



Support with returning to Syria

Many Syrians are considering returning to Syria. Perhaps you are among them. The Repatriation and Departure Service (abbreviated as DTenV) is standing by to support your return to Syria. We have set out below what we can do to help.

Who can apply for assistance?

Our assistance is intended for:

- Syrians who are currently following an asylum procedure or another residence procedure
- Syrians with a residence permit (temporary or permanent)
- Syrians who have received a return decision

We do not provide support for temporary returns, such as to visit family or to collect belongings. For full terms and conditions, please see our website:



DTenV offers the following assistance:



- **Journey:** We organise your journey and flight ticket to Syria. The route depends on the available options. Most people travel via Jordan.
- **Financial support:** Depending on your circumstances, the support will be provided either in cash or in the form of goods and services. Examples include accommodation for the first few months, training or help with setting up a business.

The table shows what support you are eligible for:

	With a residence permit or current asylum application	With a return decision
Cash at Schiphol:		
- per adult or unaccompanied minor	€3,200	€200
- per family member under the age of 18	€1,900	€40
Cash after arrival in Syria:		
- per person		€630
In the form of goods and/or services		
- per adult or unaccompanied minor		To the value of €2,450
- per family member under the age of 18		To the value of €1,230

What do you need for your return?



DTenV can arrange your journey straight away if you have a passport (valid or expired) or a laissez-passer. Do you need a replacement travel document? If so, you will need to make an appointment at the Syrian Embassy. See also the information accompanying the registration form on our website; see the QR code below. Let us know if you need help applying for a travel document.

What is the procedure for returning home?

There are 4 steps:

1: Complete the registration form on our website.

Scan the QR code on the right to open the form straight away. Make sure that you have the following details to hand:

- Your full name and V number
- Address, postcode and town/city in the Netherlands
- Your email address and telephone number



2: DTenV checks if it has all the required information.

You will receive a reply within 5 working days.

3. A member of staff will contact you to discuss your options for returning to Syria.



4. Departure for Syria, if possible.

Have you decided to leave for Syria voluntarily with our help? This means that you are withdrawing your asylum application or renouncing your residence permit. You will need to hand in your residence documents and sign a statement at Schiphol. You can view the statement via the QR code.
